#### **Important Messages**

In May 2012, a neutral third-party Arbitrator ruled that the University "... violated the parties [contract] when the Universal U-Pass and FR fees were unilaterally imposed, resulting in tuition and fees waivers not being maintained at current rates/levels."

To date, Michael Young and the University Administration are using public resources to challenge the arbitrator's decision rather than honoring its commitment under our collective bargaining agreement.
